## Entry, Glasses & Tokens

Please collect a free 2018 edition glass on entry. This acts as your receipt for your entry and beer, gin and cider will only be served to you in a 2018 glass. For Gin, you will be able to exchange your tankard for a more suitable tumbler at the Gin Bar. If your glass is accidentally broken, it can be replaced (stocks permitting) for £3.50. The broken glass must be collected and returned to the reception area.

Tokens must be used for the purchase of all beer, cider, gin and wine.

Please Note: If you have paid the reduced entrance fee for the Saturday Afternoon Session only, you must leave the festival at the end of the afternoon session, or pay £5 to upgrade to the full evening session.

## The Beers....

### A Brewery somewhere in this fine land

**Langford Licker - ABV 7.5%** - A lovely beer, but where is it from? Guess correctly and you could win a case of beer! Submit your guess at the main entrance for a chance to win!

### Brightside Brewery - Manchester

**Odin - ABV 3.8%** - Odin is a fresh, light bodied pale blonde ale brewed with European and New World hops. Expect a fruity, citrus flavour and moderately bitter finish.

### Brotherhood Brew Co. - Westbury, Wilts

**American Red - ABV 4.5%** - Pure all-American muscle. Citrus notes of orange and tangerine are topped off with an almighty drop-kick of zesty grapefruit thrown in for good measure, all thanks to the Summit hops of the USA.

### Cerne Abbas Brewery - Cerne Abbas, Dorset

**Legless Jester - ABV 4.7%** - This "best" is a single hopped beer with new British hop variety Jester, & then also dry hopped it to bring out the best of the hop. Described as fruity but not citrusy, well rounded and deceptively easy to drink.

**Tiger Tom - ABV 4.4%** - A traditional ruby mild, smooth and not bitter, well rounded with a sweet finish. Brewed with organically grown barley from the fertile Cerne Valley in deepest Dorset. Delicately hopped to complement this rich malt base. An easy drinking mild.

### Crouch Vale Brewery - Essex

**Brewer's Gold - ABV 4.0%** - Twice a Supreme Champion Beer of Britain at the Great British Beer Festival, this multi-award-winning beer is pale, refreshing and extravagantly hoppy with gorgeous aromas of tropical fruits. Brewed with 100% extra-pale English barley malt and flavoured with heaps of choicest Brewers Gold hops, sourced with care from small-scale growers in the Hallertau.

**Essex Boys Best - ABV 3.8%** - Full bodied, traditional-style mid-brown "best" brewed from 100% English barley malt and copious English Challenger and Boadicea hops, which shine through. This is a great beer of its type and a classic session beer.

### Gyle 59 Brewery - Thorncombe, Dorset

**Freedom Hiker - ABV 3.7%** - A cracking craft amber ale. A whole heap of Australian hops were included in the original recipe for additional flavour and aroma. A fruity and floral aroma is enhanced by coffee malt flavours and a long bitter finish. SIBA Silver Award Winner 2015. Unfined, hazy & vegan.

### Hopback Brewery - Downton, Salisbury

**Pacific Jade - ABV 3.9%** - This New Zealand hopped session beer is a real crowd pleaser. Herbal, lemon zest and black pepper notes will add to this super-easy drinking, very pale bitter.

### Kult Brewing Co. - Sutton Veny, Wiltshire

**Rebel - ABV 4.2%** - An American style crafty IPA which is natural, unfined and vegan. It's hazy and it's juicy and it has a sumptuous velvety feel from the malted oats. The aroma and flavour characteristics of the ale come from a well balanced use of Idaho 7 and Comet hops to give tropical fruit and citrus (think apricot, orange, red grapefruit, papaya).

### Loose Cannon Brewery - Abingdon, Oxfordshire

**Bombshell - ABV 4.2%** - A thirst quenching and tasty beer with low bitterness. The use of only pale malts really allows the hop's unique citrus flavour to shine unabated. Makes for an enticing combination in this lovely summer cruiser.

### Moor Beer Co. - Bristol

**Dead Punk All Dayer - ABV 3.5%** - Highly drinkable light tasting citrus session IPA from the Winner of the British Guild of Beer Writer's 2017 *Brewer of the year* award. Smooth and flavourful with hints of both tropical and citrus fruits, culminating in a medium dry bitter finish. Unfined, hazy & vegan.

**Raw - ABV 4.3%** - An untraditional Best Bitter! Raw has baked bread malt character, layered with herbal hops. Brewed in the Moor way with lots of extra flavour. Unfined, hazy & vegan.

### Plain Ales - Sutton Veny, Wiltshire

**Innocence - ABV 4.0%** - A golden straw coloured ale with tastes of Tangerine and Grapefruit and Malt and Caramel scents to the nose.

**Sheep Dip - ABV 3.8%** - An amber best bitter with lemon zesty start and a dry hoppy finish coming through. A great fresh session beer.

### Powderkeg Brewery - Salterton, Devon

**Brainwave - ABV 4.6%** - A great tasting, light, fresh Californian Common style beer. Hopped with Northern Brewer, Crystal & Cascade.

### Ramsbury Brewery - Ramsbury, Wiltshire

**Flint Knapper - ABV 4.2%** - 'Flint knapping' is the process making of simple tools by hand from flint. As with brewing, it's a skill that requires much care and concentration. A select blend of pale ale and chocolate malt – and Goldings hops – have given this smooth ale a rich amber colour and a taste with malty overtones.

**Wiltshire Weisse Beer - ABV 4.5%** - Brewed in Wiltshire but with roots in Bavaria, this German style Weisse beer is light, smooth, fruity and aromatic with a hint of over-ripe melon and orange. Definitely a "must try". Cloudy.

### Small Paul's Brewery - Gillingham, Dorset

**Invicta - ABV 4.2%** - From the brewer of Shiner, past beer of the Langford Beer Festival, comes Invicta. Pale, aromatic and hoppy with a long bitter finish.

**Wyvern - ABV 4.4%** - Red-brown coloured well-balanced best bitter with malt and caramel flavours and a short, bitter-sweet finish.

### St Austell Brewery - St Austell, Cornwall

**Space Hopper - ABV 4.2%** - Single hopped with Comet hops for a blend of grassy and grapefruit flavours emulating the taste of wild America! Balanced with biscuit maris otter barley malt for a very drinkable beer. Out of this world!

### Stealth Brew Co. - Melksham, Wiltshire

**Ambush - ABV 4.5%** - A quartet of New Zealand hops using Wakatu, Dr Rudi, Rakau in the boil then heavily dry hopped with Waimea in the fermenter. Unashamedly bitter with notes of pepper, herbs, pine and stone fruits in the aroma. Unfined, Vegan & Hazy.

**Camouflage - ABV 4.4%** - A great dark beer made with special de-husked barley malt which adds aroma, colour and body, with a mild, smooth flavour. Dry hopped with Mosaic. Unfined & Vegan.

### Stonehenge Brewery - Netheravon, Wiltshire

**Great Bustard - ABV 4.8%** - A dark amber coloured beer with a deep red hue traditionally brewed using Stonehenge Spring water, barley, rye, crystal and wheat malts, and whole hops. The complex malt and fruit flavours develop into a very pleasingly fruity and bitter after-taste.

**Pigswill - ABV 4.0%** - An amber coloured session ale traditionally brewed using only the finest quality ingredients. Full-bodied and not so bitter, but rich in hop aroma which gives the beer a delightful after-taste. The finish is slightly malty and fruity.

### Tintagel Brewery - Tintagel, Cornwall

**Poldark Ale - ABV 4.5%** - Just like the man himself, - dark and lively. Poldark Ale is softly fruity with a slightly bitter background and a robust hoppy aroma.

### XT Brewery - Long Crendon, Buckinghamshire

**Hop Kitty - ABV 3.9%** - A Pale Ale packed with Citra and Cascade and bursting with intense tropical and citrus flavours. Lightly toasted malts give a hint of sweetness before a second round of hops, big Mango and Lychee zest courtesy of a generous Citra third round of dry hopping.

**Lion - ABV 4.5%** - A time honoured full bodied London Porter. Brewed with a traditional recipe and re-engineered London Water. This is an easy drinking beer with a rich dark character matched with a toasty aroma and a hint of sweet earthy notes.

### Yeovil Ales - Yeovil, Somerset

**Posh IPA - ABV 5.4%** - A genuine gourmet India Pale Ale of uncompromising quality. Pale with body and mouth feel, it's strength is balanced by a truly fruity late-hopped finish.

**British Summer Time - ABV 4.5%** - BST is a zesty ultra pale ale with rounded bitterness and crisp pleasant lemon and grapefruit aromas. Almost lager like in appearance and taste - no better beer for a hot sunny day.

## The Ciders....

### **Cornish Orchards, Cornwall | Pear Cider**

**Medium Dry - ABV 5%**

A refreshing delicate, medium-dry still cider with gentle pear tones & a crisp dessert apple finish.

### **Dorset Nectar, Dorset | Hunny Bubble**

**Medium - ABV 4%**

Cider alchemy has never been finer, an artisan cider, mellow apple tones & rich with real Dorset honey.

### **Gwynt Y Ddraig, Wales | Dog Dancer**

**Medium / Dry - ABV 6.5%**

Produced from bitter-sweet cider apples blended with a true sharp cider apple, it is a light straw coloured cider with a medium dry, smooth, crisp, slightly sharp characteristic.

### **Gwynt Y Ddraig, Wales | Celtic Warrior**

**Sweet - ABV 5.5%**

Gwynt Y Ddraig's warrior with a softer side - this sweet cider is mellow and refreshing.

### **Lilley's Cider Barn, Frome | Bee Sting Still Perry**

**Sweet - ABV 7.5%**

Sweet but incredibly refreshing with a glorious fresh tasting pear flavour and a wonderful pear aroma

### **Lilley's Cider Barn, Frome | Elderflower**

**Sweet - ABV 4%**

Infused with heavenly elderflower which creates this refreshing and luxurious clean and delicate cider. Floral hints above the apple notes give a unique taste.

### **Orchard Pig, Somerset | Explorer**

**Medium - ABV 4%**

Savour the bitter-sweet richness of cider apples, followed by the lingering sweetness of ripe fruit, including notes of the dark autumn berries from the hedgerow.

### **Rich's, Henstridge, Somerset | Leg Bender**

**Medium - ABV 6%**

It's a full flavoured crisp, clear still cider, making it easy to drink, But beware can make you go weak at the knees!

### **Weymouth Cider Co., Dorset | Monkey Madness**

**Medium / Dry - ABV 4.5%**

A Medium-Dry Cider, golden in colour, a very apply pleasant to the mouth, yet still farmhouse style cider.

### **Weymouth Cider Co., Dorset | Raspberry**

**Medium - ABV 4%**

A Cider liberally imparted with British Raspberries – gorgeous colour and a wonderful taste of fresh raspberries & cider.

### **Weymouth Cider Co., Dorset | Mango**

**Sweet - ABV 4%**

Made with Mango Juice, a wonderful colour and aroma.

### **Weymouth Cider Co., Dorset | Pear & Chilli**

**Medium - ABV 4%**

Perrylicious, at a lower ABV of 4%, combined with a hint of Chilli which comes through at the end.

## The Gins....

### **Whitley Neill Rhubarb & Ginger Gin - 43%**

Subtly tart with clear rhubarb influence. A twist of orange sweetness with herbaceous coriander brings balance to the palate. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Ginger Ale or Double Dutch Pomegranate & Basil. Garnish - Blueberry.*

### **Whitley Neill Blood Orange Gin - 43%**

Bright citrus notes up front, with an intense sweetness. Balanced out with a touch of waxy orange peel, hints of pepper, cassia and thyme honey. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Orange.*

### **Whitley Neill Quince Gin - 43%**

Beautifully distinctive Turkish gin using Turkish quince which adds apple-sharp, pear sweet high notes, giving way to the sweetness of apricots and peaches. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Lime.*

### **JJ Whitley Nettle Gin - 38.6%**

Predominant nettle flavours start with a heavy herbaceous aroma and opens out in a fresh, light, zingy kick, bound together with a gentle sweetness. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Cucumber.*

### **JJ Whitley Elderflower Gin - 38.6%**

Candied sweetness dominated by the unmistakable punch of elderflower with flicks of grassiness. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Lemon.*

### **Salcombe Start Point Gin - 44%**

Citrus and floral aromas alongside earthy pine notes from Macedonian juniper, and warming spicy citrus from English Coriander seeds. Javan Cubeb berries add a fruity heat. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Cucumber.*

### **Gordon's Pink Gin - 37.5%**

Light sweetness of fresh red fruits, with a bite of juniper and coriander underneath. Lingering zesty notes of fresh raspberry. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Strawberries.*

### **Poetic License Picnic Gin - 37.5%**

The epitome of summer with the fresh taste of strawberries and cream, perfectly melded with a bright juniper gin. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Elderflower Tonic Water. Garnish - Strawbs.*

### **Ophir Oriental Spiced London Dry Gin - 40%**

Indonesian cubebs, Indian black pepper and Moroccan coriander create a unique spiced gin. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Ginger Ale. Garnish - Orange.*

### **King of Soho Gin - 42%**

Classic juniper and pine notes with a refreshing zest of citrus oil. Tangy grapefruit gives way to soft warming spice. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Lime.*

### **Malfy Gin - 41%**

Using a selection of coastal grown Italian lemons, some from Amalfi and some from Sicily, gives the gin a beautiful, fresh and zesty aroma. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Lemon.*

### **Brockmans Gin - 40%**

Sweet, fruity and contemporary, with a low prominence of Juniper. Complex, yet refreshingly smooth taste. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Indian Tonic Water. Garnish - Blueberries.*

### **Tarquins Blackberry Gin - 38%**

Tarquins' classic gin combined with delicious British Blackberries with a small helping of Cornish wildflower honey to impart a subtle mellow sweetness. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Lemon Tonic Water. Garnish - Lemon.*

### **Bloom London Dry Gin - 40%**

Floral, sweet, Honeysuckle, Pomelo and Camomile. *Pairs best with: Fever-Tree Elderflower Tonic Water. Garnish - Strawberries.*
